- 4. In which way does the story of the woman caught in the act of adultery (John 8:1-11) demonstrate why it is wrong to judge another?
- 5. Read Matthew 7:1-5. Is it ever right to judge someone else? What is Jesus' main point? Should we ever attempt to get a 'speck from our brother's eye'?
- 6. Matthew 18:15-17. Why is face-to-face better than Facebook for working through our difficulties with others?
- 7. Which of the stories that Steve told was most impactful to you? Why?
- 8. The most forgiving person is often the most forgiven person. Thoughts?
