Session 7: People of Attitude (Phil. 2:1-11)

Scriptures: Mark 10:35-45; John 13:1-17; Phil.2:1-11; 4:2-3.

- Write down in no more than 2 sentences what you believe is the essence of being a servant of God. *(Be ready with pens and paper!)*
- Read John 13:1-17. Would you have volunteered to wash the feet of your peers, if you had been one of the disciples? In which way(s) can we wash feet today?
- Do you think that there's too much talk of "rights" and too little of "responsibilities" in today's society?
- Read Phil. 1:27; 2:1-4. Why do we get the idea that all is not well in the church at Philippi? See also Phil. 4:2-3.
- Is it realistic to look out to meet the needs of others? What about the command to "consider others better than ourselves"? (Phil.2:3-4: 20-21). In which way did Timothy excel?
- Mention one deed of service done by another Christian that has impressed you? *(You don't need to mention any names, especially if that person is in your group. This would cause embarrassment!)*
- Do you think it is possible to serve Christ WITHOUT having an attitude of Christ (Phil.2:5)?
- In which ways have you personally been blessed through serving the Lord?
