## **Lifegroup Questions**

Pit Stop in the Psalms - Psalm 51 & 32 - ...and you forgave!

- Read Psalm 1:1-3 (written by David) & Acts 13:22 (Paul's summery of 1 Samuel 13:14) What do these passages of scripture teach us about David's attitude of heart?
- Read 2 Samuel 11:1-14, 26-27 What went wrong for David? What lessons can we learn from this passage? What differences do you notice between Uriah and David in this story?
- Read Psalm 51, which verses stand out to you, and why?
- Who does David say he has sinned against? (See verses 3-4) Do you find this strange?
- What does David ask God for? (See verses 10-12) How does sin lead us away from God? (see also James 1:13-15)
- What does David say God does/doesn't desire from those who have sinned? (see verses 16-17) Why is this so important?
- Read Psalm32 (written by David) What does God do when we confess our sin to him? (see also 1 John 1:5-10)
- How does David respond to God's forgiveness of his sin? (see verse 8-9) How might we use our past transgressions to benefit others?
